What makes your instructors special?

Our instructors are more than teachers. They are mentors, encouragers, and role models. Our team brings experience, passion, and a genuine love for helping dancers grow. We believe great teachers do not just teach choreography. They build relationships.

Our teaching team brings a wide range of experience, expertise, and passion to every class. We are proud to have instructors with diverse backgrounds in recreational dance, competitive dance, collegiate dance, choreography, coaching, and dance education.

Our current staff includes:

- **Four** instructors certified in **Progressing Ballet Technique (PBT)**
- **One** instructor who is a member of **Dance Masters of America**
- **Five** instructors who danced on **college dance teams**.
- **Four** instructors who have **coached high school dance teams**, including one who was honored as the **ISDTA 2025 Coach of the Year**.
- **Multiple instructors whose choreography has received overall, judges', and choreography awards at regional and national competitions**

We also believe in continuing to learn and grow as educators so we can provide our dancers with high-quality training while creating an encouraging, inspiring, and positive environment for every student.

How do instructors provide feedback?

At Bold, corrections are part of growth. We teach dancers that feedback is not criticism. It is an opportunity to become stronger. Our instructors provide corrections in a positive, encouraging way while celebrating each dancer's progress.

How do you support different learning styles?

Every dancer learns differently.

Our teachers use:

- Demonstration
- Verbal instruction
- Individual feedback
- Encouragement
- Confidence-building techniques

We meet dancers where they are and help them grow from there.

THE BOLD CULTURE

What makes Bold different?

We believe our biggest strength is **our culture**.

From the moment you walk through our doors, we want you to feel the difference. You'll find a studio where dancers cheer for one another, families celebrate each other's successes, and **kindness is the expectation—not the exception**.

At Bold, we have no room for "dance mom" drama, bullying, gossip, or meanness. We believe dance should be a place where every child feels safe, supported, and excited to learn. We work hard to create an environment where families lift each other up, encourage one another, and model the same respect and kindness we expect from our dancers. We teach our dancers that being a great teammate is just as important as being a great performer. They learn to celebrate each other's accomplishments, encourage one another through challenges, and understand that **there is room for everyone to shine**.

At the end of the day, we're not just building strong dancers—we're building a community of confident, respectful, and compassionate young people. That's what makes Bold feel like home.

How do you handle bullying or exclusion?

At Bold, kindness matters.

We work hard to create a space where every dancer feels welcomed, included, and valued. **We do not tolerate bullying, negativity, or behaviors that make another dancer feel less than.**

How do you promote confidence and positive body image?

At Bold, we believe every **BODY** can dance.

We celebrate every dancer for who they are and the unique strengths they bring to the studio. Every body is different, every journey is different, and every dancer deserves to feel confident, capable, and valued.

Our focus is on what a dancer's body can **do**, not what it looks like. We encourage healthy habits, build confidence through accomplishment, and create an environment where dancers feel empowered to be themselves.'

We are also **intentional about the costumes we choose**. We select costumes that are age-appropriate, thoughtfully designed, and made to help dancers of all body shapes and sizes feel comfortable, confident, and proud when they step on stage.

At the end of the day, our goal is simple: for every dancer to walk through our doors knowing they belong here. Because at Bold, everyBODY has a place to dance.

SAFETY AND WELL-BEING

How do you prioritize dancer safety?

Our dancers are our greatest responsibility.

Nothing is more important to us than the safety and well-being of our dancers. As parents, mentors, and educators, we take that responsibility seriously every single day. Creating a safe environment goes far beyond preventing injuries. We want every dancer who walks through our doors to feel physically safe, emotionally supported, and comfortable being themselves.

We prioritize safety by:

- Hiring qualified, caring instructors who put dancers first
- Recording all classes
- Completing staff screenings
- Teaching proper technique, warm-ups, and conditioning to help reduce the risk of injury
- Encouraging dancers to listen to their bodies and speak up if something doesn't feel right
- Maintaining open, honest communication with families

What happens if a dancer is injured?

If an injury occurs, we respond quickly and communicate with families.

The dancer's health and safety always come first.

How do you approach injury prevention?

We believe strong dancers are built safely.

Our training includes:

- Strength and conditioning
- Proper technique
- Flexibility development
- Safe progressions

We encourage dancers to speak up if something does not feel right.

COMMITMENT AND EXPECTATIONS

Are performances required?

We know that every dancer and every family is different, and we want dance to fit your life—not the other way around.

Many of our dancers love the excitement of performing in our annual recital, but it's not the right fit for everyone. If your dancer simply wants to come to class each week, learn new skills, make friends, and have fun, that's absolutely okay too! At Bold, dancers can enjoy the experience of dance without the expectation of performing.

For families interested in additional performance opportunities, we offer our annual recital, community events, and our Bold Dance Collective competition program, each with their own level of commitment.

Our goal is to provide opportunities for every dancer, whether they're here to perform on stage, compete, or simply dance because they love it.

What additional costs should families expect?
